The counselling centre for academic social work is neutral and independent. We work directly within school facilities and can therefore recognise and act immediately if children or adolescents display problems, or if conflicts within peer groups occur. Children and adolescents can drop by our centre anytime without notice.

We are also the first place of contact for parents whose children attend school in Winterthur.

We are under the professional pledge of secrecy and our service is voluntarily and free of charge.
