

If you are moving within the city of Winterthur or have recently moved, please remember that address changes must be reported to the Residents' Registration Office within 14 days.

You can report your address change in the following ways:

- Online via <u>eUmzugCH</u> (not valid for weekly residents):
  - A purchase, rental, or sublease agreement, or another form of housing confirmation, is required.
- By phone
- In person at the Residents' Registration Office counter:
  - A purchase, rental, or sublease agreement, or another form of housing confirmation, is required.
  - Passport or identity card (original document) is required.
  - Residence permit (original document) is also required for foreign nationals.

## **Reporting minors**

A move (to, from, or within Winterthur) involving children under the age of 18 may only be reported by a **legal guardian**.

- If the parents live at different addresses, a **completed declaration** must be submitted to the Residents' Registration Office.
- Court rulings or KESB (Child and Adult Protection Authority)
  decisions regarding custody must be presented upon request.

**Important**: In the case of a **move abroad**, the **signature of both legal guardians** on the declaration is mandatory.
