

## Reporting a Move – Here's How

### Notification by Residents

If you are [moving](#) to Winterthur, [changing address](#) within the city, or [moving away](#), you can register, update, or cancel your residence **online** or **in person** at the Residents' Registration Office.

### Notification for School-Age Children

Please also notify the [School Administration](#) if your school-age child is moving to, within, or away from Winterthur. If you have questions, the School Administration will be happy to assist you.

### Notification to Stadtwerk Winterthur

Don't forget to notify [Stadtwerk Winterthur](#) separately about your move – for example, regarding **electricity, water, or gas** services.

### Notification by Landlords (Third-Party Reporting Obligation)

Property managers, landlords, hosts, and main tenants are legally required to report the **move-in or move-out of tenants** within 14 days of the move, in accordance with the third-party reporting obligation (via the [online portal for third-party notifications](#)).
